

Motion to approve the October treasurer's report was made by Nena and seconded by Sharon.

Motion to approve the October minutes was made by Danielle and seconded by Barb.

A motion to approve the new award guidelines that will take place in 2015 was made by Nena and seconded by Barb.

A discussion was held on handing hard copies of the association's handbook out at the annual banquet.

The 2015 Classics was discussed. Advertising is out and judges are hired. An added bonus of prize money will be awarded at Fourth Level or higher. The specific tests will be determined closer to the show date.

The Combined Training portion of the Championship Show was reviewed. Motion was made by Nena and seconded by Barb to try to move it to another weekend and better venue in order to get more participation in Combined Training by members.

New education opportunities were brought up. On May 16-17, 2015, Rebecca O'Bea will be doing a Western Dressage Clinic, followed by a schooling show. The location has not been determined yet. Dolly Hannon has agreed to do a clinic September 5-6, 2015 with possible locations of Ellsworth Community College or Tamarack Stables.

Motion to adjourn was made by Danielle and seconded by Sharon. Meeting adjourned at 8:08p.m.

Next meeting will be the Annual Awards Banquet on January 4, 2015 at 12:30p.m. at the Des Moines Golf & Country Club.

### **Top 6 Ways To Ramp It Up For Show Season**

Preparing for the show season may not be as easy as it looks. There are many aspects that go into getting to the show ring, and even more that need to be done before you even set your first trailer tires onto the road. Have a great time at the show!



6. Set your end-of-the-season goals. What can you realistically expect to achieve by the championships? Break each goal down into a series of mini-steps that work you back to where you and your horse are now. Start at the beginning but set a timeline that enables you to achieve those long-term goals about a month before your championships.

5. Build momentum. Setting a routine is an essential component to showing. You need to develop momentum in everything from knowing what equipment you need to take with you for the show, to establishing habits for packing all the extras that you will need once you are off-property.

4. Take your horse on a field trip. Just like people, horses need time to develop their routines. Although your horse may have loaded perfectly by the end of last show season, taking him on a trip to another friendly and low-key facility will enable him to get into his groove. He can get the feel for unloading in a strange place and performing immediately after arrival. Have a blast during the field trip and you will help develop a positive attitude that will transfer to the show ring once the pressure is on. Take more than one trip if necessary. Your horse will tell you when he has found his routine.

3. Practice your show requirements. If you are showing in dressage, know those tests inside out and backward! If you are going for a hunter/jumper round, practice the common courses you will likely see in the show ring. Practice the patterns for western performance, and break down the barrel runs into minicomponents that require the horse to go through the motions of show day. If you compete in competitive trail, take your horse away to a friendly trail system and ride half the distance of your event at competition speed. Try to "win your ribbons" at home before you even leave your own sand.

2. Pack a good attitude. Know that you and your horse are going to do your best on the given day under the given circumstances. Set your reasonable goals for the day and try to achieve them. Ribbons are the icing on the cake, but I guarantee that "if you build it", the ribbons will come! However, if everything falls apart, don't despair! Just go home, regroup, and "get back on the horse" for another day. It happens to all of us!

1. Do it all again! It is true that it takes several shows for you and your horse to get accustomed to all the routines and variations in your day. Showing in the morning will feel very different from performing in the afternoon or at the end of the day. Different locations will offer differing amenities and both you and your horse need to experience and adapt to those changes. There is no replacement for experience, and with practice, your day will flow smoothly and effortlessly.

So get out there and start ramping it up for your show season!

### IaDCTA Awards

The IaDCTA Awards program is designed to recognize achievement of those riders who consistently earn good scores and advances their riding level, and encourages a high standard of horsemanship in Dressage, Combined Training, and Western Dressage at IaDCTA-approved shows.

### **Guidelines for All Awards**

 Only Scores from IaDCTA Recognized Dressage, Combined Training, and Western Dressage Shows will be counted towards IaDCTA Awards.

- Rider of the horse must be an IaDCTA member at the time qualifying scores are earned.
- Each Horse must be registered at the time qualifying scores are earned.
- A Rider may only qualify to win at two consecutive levels on the same horse, but Riders may qualify as many Horses as they wish.

5. If Riders share a Horse, the Horse will be limited to four rides per day at two consecutive levels, and only one Horse and Rider combination per level or class.

- A protective ASTM approved hard hat with chin harness must be worn when mounted regardless of rider's age or level of competency.
- A Rider is not allowed to enter more than 1 division. (i.e., cannot enter Open and AA.) Definitions of Rider Divisions:

A. Adult Amateur (AA): for Dressage, competitors shall compete as Adults from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach age 22 (USEF rules GR101). B. Open division is for professionals as described by USEF rules GR1306.

- C. Young Riders (JR/YR) are 21 and under.
- D. Junior 14 (JR14) are 14 years and under.

Dressage and Western Dressage Scores must be equal to or greater than 58.000% to count towards IaDCTA Awards. Combined Training Results will be submitted as a placing for the class and awarded points towards a minimum point total to qualify for IaDCTA Awards. Complete one type of service per Rider. Volunteer hours can only be earned by IaDCTA

members, and gifted to other IaDCTA members.

- A. Complete 7 hours of volunteer time at IaDCTA Recognized events.
- Recruit 4 new members to IaDCTA.
- C. Donate \$200.00 cash to IaDCTA.

10. The IaDCTA Show Series Year runs from January 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31st. (2014 Championship Schooling Show results counts towards 2015 awards.)

11. Championship rides (IaDCTA, Regional, or other Championships) do not count towards IaDCTA Awards.

### **Qualifying Scores for Awards**

For example, to Qualify for Training level Dressage: 5 tests scoring 58.000% or higher must be earned from at least three different judges and one of those scores must be from the highest test of the level.
